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INDEPENDENT PRACTITIONERS' REVIEW ENGAGEMENT REPORT

To Chief and Council of Yaqit ?a·knuqti'it

We have reviewed the Schedule of Remuneration and Expenses of Chief and Council of Yaqit ?a·knuqti'it for the year ended March 31, 2021, and other explanatory information (together "the schedule"). The schedule has been prepared by management in accordance with the requirements of the Indigenous Services Canada ("ISC") Reporting Guide.

The procedures performed in a review are substantially less in extent than, and vary in nature from, those performed in an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion on this schedule.
