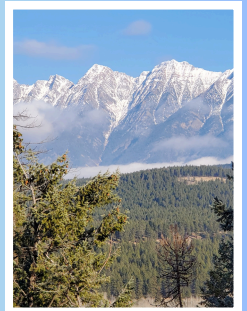

Competition Categories

- Juniors (0-12): 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place
- Teens (13-17): 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place
- Adult Male (18-55): 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place
- Adult Female (18-55): 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place
- Seniors (55+): 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place

Additional Prize Categories

- Smallest fish
- Biggest fish
- Most fish
- First fish
- Last fish



Competition Guidelines

- One designated judge will oversee the competition to ensure consistency
- Every fish must be weighed and measured by the official judge
- A competition perimeter will be in place to ensure judges have easy access to all participants
- Yaqit ʔa·knuqʔiʔit band members may bring two non-Indigenous guest
- Yaqit ʔa·knuqʔiʔit band members will have their own selection of prizes, separate from non-member/non-Indigenous prizes
- Both spin-cast and fly fishing are eligible
- All participants must sign the waiver issued at registration
